Create a Dynamic Implementation Repository

As an open standards Community: we'd like to set up an open, dynamic Blockchain Implementation repository

So that:

the Community can learn from real world, tried and true implementation successes and failures (modeling after Lean Startup mindset “fail fast, learn fast”)

We are done when:

1) We have created working dynamic Blockchain that contains our industry use cases

2) 3rd Parties can easily leverage this resource as a Blockchain educational resource
