Topics & Minutes:

- TPAC 2022 interest and concerns
 - Seems like we prefer not to meet in person
 - If there is a reason our group needs to meet in person, we should consider it. But as-is, our group seems to be progressing well
- tRNS chunk ambiguity
 - Should we allow the ambiguity or resolve it?
 - If we should resolve it, should we favor ignoring unused bits or treating non-zero as an error in the chunk/image?
 - Also, transparent values out of range are currently treated as opaque black.

Action Items:

- Normative references should be made to match ReSpec styling
- Perhaps we should add a note that some images may be non-conformant for tRNS chunks setting unused bits to 1
 - If we find a pressing need, we can act on it. But right now, it seems like these are specially crafted images rather than normal images found in the wild.
- Transparent values beyond the palette index don't seem to be a problem. Forcing spec changes for a non-problem is a heavy handed approach. We can put it on the backburner for now.
