Text and Data Mining

* "'text and data mining' means any automated analytical technique aimed at analysing text and data in digital form in order to **generate information** which includes but is not limited to patterns, trends and correlations"

EU Copyright Directive

- * Copyright exception for scientific research by research organizations and institutions (across the Union).
- * **Exception** or limitation to the rights of (*EU*?) rightsholders **on lawfully accessible content** (*stored in EU*?), for reproductions and extractions for the purposes of TDM.
- * BUT ... on the condition that the use of such content for TDM has not been expressly reserved by their rights holders in an appropriate manner, <u>such as</u> machine-readable means in the case of content made publicly available online.
- * = OPT-OUT by rights holders from the copyright exception

Deadline

* Member States have until June 2021 to implement into national law the provisions of the EU Directive.

Project

- * **Be open**, try to join together the publishing and TDM sectors and find a simple solution to this simple problem.
- * The Publishing sector started by expressing:
 - * Requirements (what the solution should offer)
 - * Use cases (examples of usage of the solution)
- * Then TDM sector + tech arm of publishing sector find a non-binding solution to recommend to publishers of all sorts.

Requirements

- * The solution shall:
 - * Specify how a rightsholder can indicate that TDM rights are reserved on a **Web page** he controls.
 - * Specify how a rightsholder can indicate that TDM rights are reserved on **each individual Web resource** he controls, at least when such Web resources are present **in a Web page**.
 - * Specify how the rightsholder can indicate whether a licence for TDM rights is available (in case TDM rights are reserved).
 - * Specify how a TDM agent can apply for a TDM license.
 - * Specify a machine-readable format for TDM licenses.

Use cases

- * Use Case 1: a newspaper provides information with TDM opt-out
- * Use Case 2: a publisher provides free extracts of ebooks with TDM opt-out
- * Use Case 3: an academic publishing platform provides HTML and PDF articles with TDM opt-out and possibility to get a license
- * Use Case 4: a subscription service provides EPUB files with TDM opt-out

- * Reach a broad support from the EU publishing sector (around the FEP)
 - * Work document available on demand.
- * Have the international TDM sector onboard (as much as possible)
- * Design a <u>simple</u> technical solution, to be taken into account during implementations into EU national laws + recommended to all EU publishers.
