- language: dcterms:language and point to lexvo Language vocabulary

May

- ShortName: Michel came back with dcterms:alternative and skos:prefLabel but neither capture the shortness aspect
- keyword: (In MAY due to the burden of adding it) Should link to a taxonomy of keywords but can use strings if need be; foaf:topic points to documents not the topic; Recommend the use of dcat:theme for URIs and dcat:keyword for strings
- rights: dcterms:rights (Some confusion as to the difference between license and rights. Anyone know of a good document that gives the distinction?)
