

Call for Post Doc positions in the Indo-Italian Project on Semantic Search in Peer-Peer Distributed Systems

Semantic Search in Peer-Peer Distributed Systems is the research theme being actively pursued under the Indo-Italian project at Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IIT, Madras) and University of Trento, Italy. The project is actively looking for post docs who could spend time at IIT, Madras and University of Trento, Italy. The total duration of the project is two years. The project is being coordinated by Prof. D. Prospective candidates need to have done their Ph.D in an area relevant to the project and should be willing to spend time at both Institutes in India and Italy (indicatively, one year each). Teachers who have done their Ph.D recently and working in engineering colleges in India can also apply.
