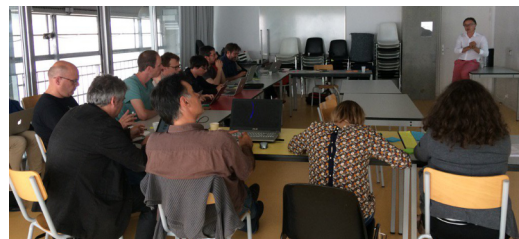
Submission Details and Format
